Signature Card Template

This template can be placed on a standard 3"x 5" or any solid cardboard like a file folder, or thick plastic sheet. Cut out the rectangle in the middle, draw a line through the middle of hole on card, so folks have a place to line up the signature line. Or you can just print this template on 8.5 x 11 card stock in your printer. Then cut around outside line and inside box.

Remember that using this signature guide when people first meet you:

- Signals that you are "educated" in ways to make accommodations people with blindness
- This aid works for any kind, or degree of blindness
- Provides a sense of freedom and empowerment to sign "straight" in the right place without being touched or struggling
- Makes them aware that you are willing to talk about their needs
- Shows respect for their personal space.
- Allows them to know you believe with the right tools/skills, they can be successful and independent.
